| | <i>This Pinot Grigio is crisp, refreshing and unoaked. The bouquet is unmistakable and immediate, with an intense impression of acacia flowers. The palate is dry, full-bodied and well-balanced. From 2017 vintage this wine has accredited DOC status.</i> | | |
| 2 | Sauvignon Blanc, "Marcel Martin", Loire Valley, France | £5.50 | £19 |
| | <i>A lovely fresh Sauvignon from the Loire Valley. Glass filling aromas of gooseberry and grapefruit notes. Fresh and vibrant with nicely integrated acidity, some complexity and a deliciously long refreshing finish.</i> | | |
